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Database on global citizenship and civic engagement

The database integrates materials, resources, good practices, articles, cases, videos in global citizenship and civic engagement for intellectual disabilities young adults in the European Union. It contains different fields dealing with Human Rights, Agenda 2030 and Sustainable Development Goals, Climate change, Gender equality and Construction of peaceful and fair environments.

The database provides users a personalized learning path to learn more about specific topics or to improve some global citizenship skills and knowledge that will allow them to increase their civic commitment so that impact is expected to be significant as users will be able to reach goals which fulfil the strategy at their preference with immediate results.

Platform of the blended training for staff members and trainers: Methodology and Contents

The Moodle platform is an intellectual output developed with the aim of supporting the training blended activity for staff members and trainers on global citizenship and civic engagement among young adults with intellectual disabilities. The training part is based on the Handbook on Global citizenship and civic engagement.
